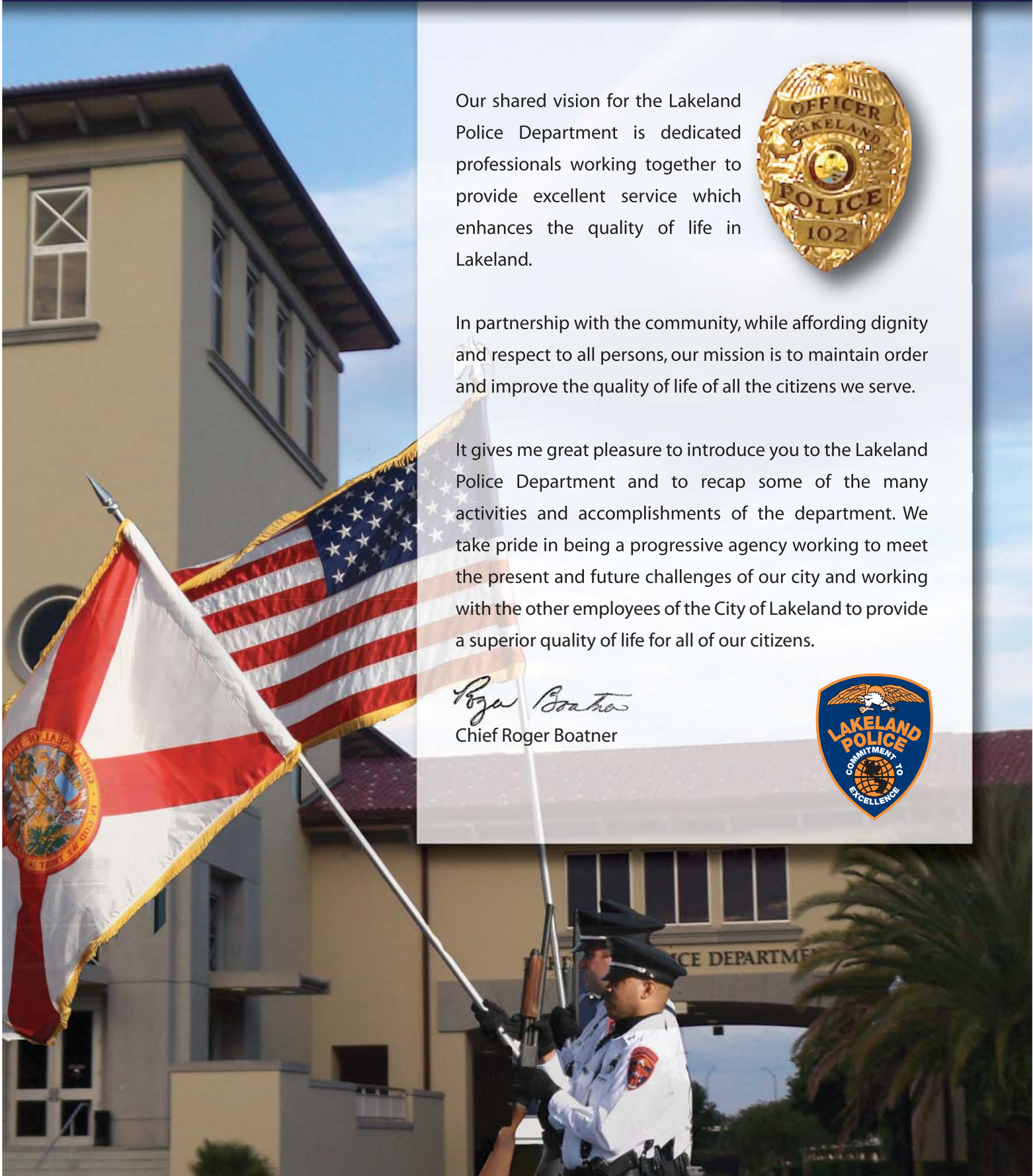
Our shared vision for the Lakeland Police Department is dedicated professionals working together to provide excellent service which enhances the quality of life in Lakeland.

DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Lakeland Police Department serves a medium-sized city with a total land area of approximately 73 square miles and a 2007 population of approximately 93,428

The department is divided into three bureaus plus the Chief's office and his direct reports. The three bureaus are the Administrative Services Bureau (ASB), the Investigative Services Bureau (ISB), and the Neighborhood Services Bureau (NSB). The primary duties of the ASB are recruiting, training, and career development. The primary duties of the ISB are criminal investigations, the crime lab, and victim assistance. The primary duties of the NSB are the patrol divisions, traffic units, and special operations.

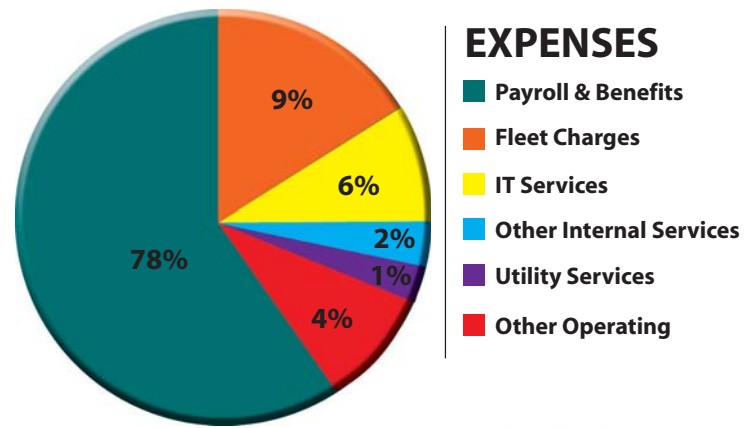

BUDGET OVERVIEW

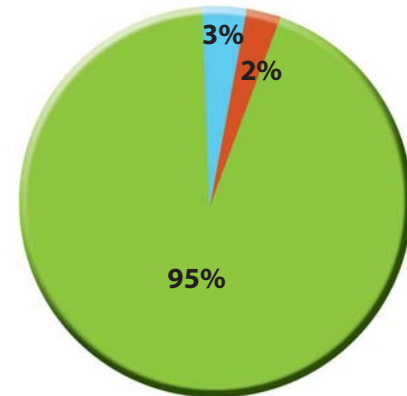

NATIONALLY ACCREDITED

The Lakeland Police Department is nationally accredited through the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). This certification requires that the department comply with over 400 rigorous standards and that we be re-certified every three years for continued compliance to these standards.
